

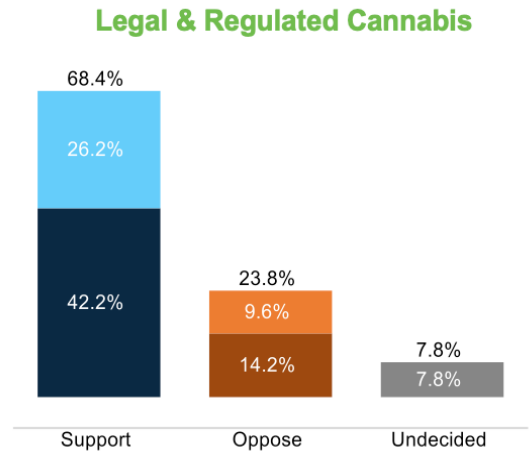


Voters Mandate Legal and Regulated Cannabis In This Legislative Session

Across Ideological Lines, Voters Support Legal Cannabis

- Support for **adult use cannabis** reaches two-thirds of voters (67%) in the district. Only one-in-four (24%) **oppose** adult use cannabis.
- Majorities of **Republicans** (55%), **unaffiliated** (66%), and **Democrat** voters (80%) support adult use cannabis.
- **Legal and regulated cannabis** sees similar strength at 68% support, 24% oppose. Support again spans the partisan and ideological spectrum.
- More than half of voters (53%) say that **legalizing cannabis during this legislative session is crucial to stimulate economic growth**.
- A majority of **Democrats** (65%), **unaffiliated** voters (52%), and **Republicans** (41%) say legalization should happen now. Only 26% of Republicans are opposed.
- A third of voters would be **more likely to vote for a candidate that supports non-medical cannabis** (34%) compared to 12% saying they would vote for someone else. 48% say it would make no difference in their vote.



Tomlinson's Bipartisan Appeal Fuels Solid Lead

- **Representative K.C. Tomlinson leads on the State House Ballot** at 48% over Anand Patel at 41%.
- The **Generic Ballot** shows a 3% Democrat advantage at 45% **Republican**, 48% **Democrat**.
- The Democrat advantage widens on the **Presidential Ballot** with **Harris** leading 51% to **Trump** at 44%.
- **Tomlinson overperforms a generic Republican** among many demographic groups but most prominently with young voters, older voters, college educated women, and Democrats.

METHODOLOGY

This probabilistic survey was conducted October 1 - 3, 2024, with 316 likely general election voters. It has a margin of error of ±5.49%. Known registered voters were interviewed via live phones, online panel, and SMS. This survey was weighted to a likely general election voter universe.
